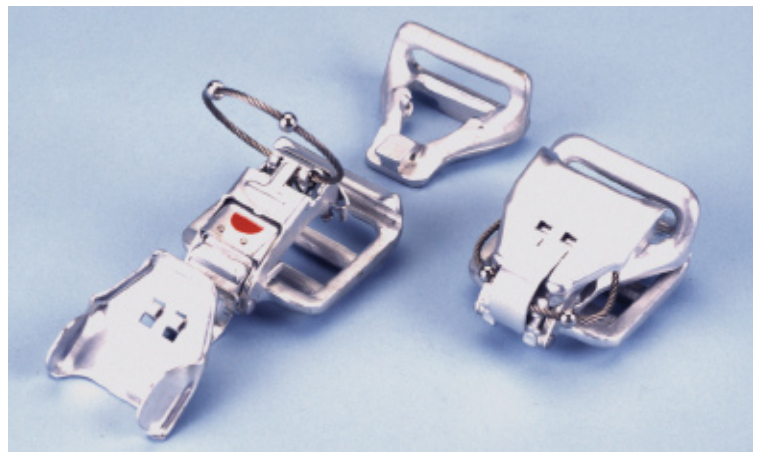

The Capewell Parachute Canopy Release is drop forged steel, constructed for superior strength, and cadmium plated for increased corrosion resistance. The max load of the unit is 9000 pounds. Each component undergoes 100% inspection and each finished release is subjected to a 5000 lbs (2268 kg) pull test. All parachute hardware is manufactured under stringent ISO 9001 quality control standards.
